

BECOMING A REGISTERED YOUTH WORKER REQUIRES TWO STEPS:

1. [Application](#) process
2. Complete the required training.

As a reminder, individuals are not formally recognized as certified until their application is approved and the training is complete. Mission Centers are responsible for updating Shelby records to make this official.

OPTIONS TO COMPLETE THE REQUIRED TRAINING:

- Recommended:
 - Best option is to attend a live training provided by a local mission center.
 - Another good option is to participate in the [CIMM course](#) training. *(click Offerings and scroll to see the course list)*
